As the seasons change to Fall and Winter, being aware of how you impact stormwater runoff is more important than ever! Do your part to protect our resources with the following:

"STORMWATER SMART" REMINDERS



- \* Before raking your yard free of leaves, consider mulch-mowing your leaves back into the grass. This can help strengthen the soil and reduce stormwater runoff. Better yet just leave some leaves on the ground!
- \* Leave perennials and annuals instead of cutting them back, as they help provide important habitat to pollinators during the cold months and can help catch excess runoff.
- \* A little salt goes a long way! Do not over apply deicing materials, and opt for nontoxic, pet-friendly options. Store materials under cover and in a leak proof container.
- \* Pile snow on vegetated areas and away from storm drains, pipes or ditches. Snow melt can soak directly into the ground and help decrease runoff.
